Map drainage areas which contribute to stormwater outfalls in GIS, including high risk areas. Conduct routine visual inspections of 50% of outfalls once per year. Obtain dry weather water quality data from 7 outfalls. Remove combined sewer connections as they are found.

**B. Briefly summarize the observations that indicated the overall effectiveness of this Measurable Goal.**

The Village inspected and repaired/replaced 1 drywells and 4 catch basins. They observed visual characteristics of the water, did not collect samples. Preliminary mapping of stormsewer drainage areas and features was conducted under the Washington County MS4 project, this collection is ongoing. The Village does not have funds to CCTV inspect 25% of their storm system each year without grant funding.

The Village will continue to visually inspect water quality at outfalls. Funding assistance will be required to inspect 25% of the storm system each year as the Village cannot afford to pay for this work. Illicit discharges are eliminated as they are found. The Village continues to replace catch basins connected to the CS with drywells. Under the Washington County MS4 project the Village will map the entire MS4 area to GIS and make it available through the county GIS services.
